BOOKING INFORMATION (as of 17 May 2026)

We are very pleased to announce that the meditation master Shree Shivkrupanand Swami (Swamiji) and his wife Guruma will be coming to Europe in summer 2026.

With great joy, we can announce that **this year's Guru Purnima festival with Swamiji and Guruma** will be celebrated in Germany as part of their Europe tour.

One of their wishes is to support the final financing for the construction of our non-profit Meditation Hall (Gurushaktidham Europe), to which this retreat is also intended to contribute.

As the large Guru Purnima celebration with Swamiji usually takes place in India, this is a very special and unique gift for us here in the West.

Guru Purnima is an important Indian festival celebrated every year on the full moon in July.

Both meditators and non-meditators are warmly invited to experience this special festival live together with Swamiji in Germany.

The discourses are expected to be held with English translation.

We are very much looking forward to welcoming you on this very special occasion!

Date and Venue

The retreat will take place at the Sauerland Stern Hotel in Germany (North Hesse).

Participation and booking are only **possible for the entire duration**, not for individual days.

The Sauerland Stern Hotel requests that all accommodation bookings be made **exclusively via the booking portal of our association** and not via the hotel or any online portal (see below).



Check-in and end of the retreat

Check-in takes place on Tuesday, 28 July 2026 at 3:00 PM German time (UTC+2).

Earlier check-in may be possible; this will be confirmed in the week before the retreat begins.

The program ends on Thursday, 30 July 2026 after lunch.

How to reach the retreat venue

The hotel is located in the idyllic Sauerland region and is easily accessible by public transport and by car.

Address: Sauerland Stern Hotel, Kneippweg 1, 34508 Willingen, Germany

The nearest **train station** is Willingen (500 m from the venue).

The nearest **international airport** is Frankfurt Airport. From there it takes approx. 2.5 hours by car to the hotel (190 km).

There are also closer airports in Paderborn-Lippstadt (70 km), Kassel, and Dortmund.

The hotel is surrounded by beautiful nature and offers various leisure activities (<https://www.willingen.de/>).



Bus transfer

In the booking portal, it is possible to register for a bus transfer from Frankfurt Airport to the Guru Purnima venue and back. Payment for this service will be made at a later stage or on site.

Expected times:

→ 28.07., 9:00 AM (CEST): Frankfurt Airport → Sauerland Stern Hotel

→ 30.07., approx. 4:00 PM (CEST): Sauerland Stern Hotel → Frankfurt Airport

The bus journey takes about 3 hours, so you will arrive back at Frankfurt Airport on Thursday evening.

Visit to the Samarpan Centre Europe before or after Guru Purnima

You are warmly invited to take the opportunity to visit the Samarpan Centre Europe (Dhyansthali Europe) in Bad Soden-Salmünster (Hesse) **before or after the retreat.**

The Samarpan Centre Europe, where our Meditation Hall (Gurushaktidham) is currently being built, is located approximately a 1-hour drive from Frankfurt Airport and around a 3-hour drive from the Guru Purnima retreat venue.

It may also be possible that a bus transfer for these journeys will be organised at a later stage.

Accommodation during the retreat

Accommodation during the retreat is **exclusively at the Sauerland Stern Hotel**. Staying in campers or external accommodation is not possible.

Please note that dogs cannot be brought to the retreat.

Couples and families may share a room; otherwise, gender separation applies.

Accessible rooms are available for wheelchair users.

Room bookings for the retreat days must be made exclusively via our booking portal.

If you wish to stay at the Sauerland Stern Hotel a **few days before or after the retreat**, please also book these additional nights via our booking portal and **not** via the hotel or an online platform.

This allows you to stay in the same room throughout your entire stay.

Additional nights outside the retreat period include breakfast and will be paid directly at the hotel on site.

Rooms and prices for the Retreat

The program is non-commercial and is conducted free of charge by Shree Shivkrupanand Swami.

The costs cover all expenses incurred during the Guru Purnima retreat, including full board accommodation, tourist tax, room rental, technology, flowers, and materials.

Depending on availability, shared twin and triple rooms can be booked. Single rooms are not available.



Total retreat costs including accommodation and full board

- with **Triple room accommodation**: €360 per person (15 years and older)
- with **Twin room accommodation**: €400 per person (15 years and older)

CHILDREN

- **6–14 years**: €175 when booked with two full-paying adults
- **0–5 years**: free when booked with two full-paying adults

Booking options

There are two booking options in the portal: individual booking and family booking.

Individual booking

Individual booking is for persons aged 15 and over in double or triple rooms.

In the booking portal you can indicate who you would like to share a room with. Please coordinate this **in advance** and ensure that the first and last name matches exactly as registered by the other person.

Each person books and pays individually.

It is also possible to book without a preferred roommate. In this case, room allocation is done by the hotel.

Family booking

Family booking is exclusively for families with children aged 0–14 years.

According to hotel regulations, **two adults** must stay in the room, each paying the double room rate.

A maximum of five people per family room is allowed (2 adults and up to 3 children).

For single parents or individuals travelling with children, there is the option to share a family room with another adult.

If you are looking for someone, please email us at welcome@samarpan-meditation.de. A WhatsApp group will be created to connect families and help form suitable room arrangements.

The booking of the family room is made collectively by one person.

Meals

Meals during the retreat are full board, vegetarian (without eggs), from Tuesday evening to Thursday lunch.

Allergies and intolerances can also be specified during booking.

Booking and payment

Please read our **terms and conditions including cancellation policies** carefully, as you agree to them upon booking.

Please register by Sunday, June 7, 2026 – places are limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

100% of the total amount is due at the time of booking.

A retreat booking is only confirmed once payment has been received in the bank account of Samarpan Meditation Deutschland e.V.

During booking, you will be automatically redirected to online payment and donation options.

To keep fees as low as possible, we recommend **payment via SEPA**.

IMPORTANT: Your registration consists of two parts!

1. Registration/booking/payment for accommodation including a fixed cost contribution covering organisational expenses and full board during the retreat

2. Afterwards, you can make the **donation for the construction of the Meditation Hall (Gurushaktidham Europe)**

Kindly note that the prices shown during retreat registration / accommodation booking do **NOT** yet include the donation.

Warm invitation to support our non-profit project

At the Samarpan Centre Europe (Dhyansthal) near Frankfurt, a very special Meditation Hall (Gurushaktidham) is currently being built. It is intended to be a peaceful place where people can find rest and connect with their inner source of strength.

The Meditation Hall will be open to all people across Europe and beyond.

To make this wonderful construction project possible and to inaugurate it, the meditation master Shree Shivkrupanand Swami (Swamiji) will travel from India together with his wife Guruma this year.



It is Swamiji's great wish that donations for the Meditation Hall in Europe are collected during the Guru Purnima retreat so that the first construction phase can be fully financed.

It would be wonderful if you support this wish and take the minimum recommendation into consideration when making your donation.

If you feel inspired to donate beyond the recommended amount, this helps us collectively carry the remaining open amount of approximately €500,000.

At the Guru Purnima Retreat 2026, many participants will not need to undertake the long journey to India, including flight costs, as the program takes place in Europe — a beautiful opportunity to take this aspect into account in one's personal decision.

The recommended donation is €250 per adult person — though of course there is no upper limit ❤️

All participants will be kept informed about further retreat details via email.

This includes information on what to bring, travel and accommodation, current updates on the program schedule, as well as other organisational information.

In the further course, you will also receive a link to our WhatsApp community "Guru Purnima 2026 * Participants".

This group serves as an additional channel for sharing up-to-date information leading up to the retreat in both German and English.

Within this community, additional groups will also be created to help participants find carpooling and shared travel options, as well as for exchange and questions.
